- Registration:** All NOCPH registration is handled on-line via the University of Toledo Health Science Campus Registrar's Office located at the first floor of the Mulford Library Building. NOTE: MPH students do not register for 800-level cross-listed courses; these are reserved for applicable doctoral students. For registration, please see the instructions that follow:

#### REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS:

You may register and pay for your courses by logging on to **myUT** portal at <http://myut.utoledo.edu/>. Enter your UTAD username and password then select the "Self Service" tab and follow the student links to enter your Spring 2010 registration. If you experience difficulties with your UTAD account, activate or reset your password at <https://myutaccount.utoledo.edu> or call the help desk at 419.530.2400. If you encounter other difficulties with Student Self Service not addressed here, you may call 419.383.4224 during normal business hours. A registration assistant will work with you and attempt to resolve your problem so you can continue your registration via the web. You may search for courses through the "Self Service" tab of the **myUT** portal or, you may search without logging into the portal [here](#). **Student Self Service is normally unavailable from 3:00 AM until 5:00 AM for system maintenance.**

#### FEES:

Once fees have been assessed, you will receive notification at your official University of Toledo e-mail address; [firstname.lastname@rockets.utoledo.edu](mailto:firstname.lastname@rockets.utoledo.edu). You will also receive information regarding the payment due date in the e-bill notification. Please note that fees will continue to be assessed at the student's highest level of matriculation in any semester. For example, if a student is matriculated at the medical level and would like to take a graduate course, medical level fees will be assessed for all courses. A new service available for students on the Health Science Campus, and thus a new fee that will appear on your bill starting in summer 2008 is the Student Legal Fee. All students are assessed the Student Legal Fee unless they indicate the desire to waive it. We encourage all students to consider this valuable service. **FERPA:**

The **Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act** of 1974, otherwise known as FERPA, is a Federal Law and was introduced to give students certain rights regarding the confidentiality of their educational records. FERPA gives colleges and universities the ability to release non-academic information, or "directory information", **without the written consent of the student.**

Directory information includes:

- student name
- local address and local phone number
- college and major field of study
- full-time or part-time enrollment status
- class rank
- e-mail address
- dates of attendance
- degrees and awards received

Students may restrict the release of their Directory Information by selecting the "Update Directory Information Release Status" found under the **Student Self Service Auxiliary Functions** on the Self Service tab of the myUT. Please keep in mind that if you decide to restrict your directory information, then any requests for such items as enrollment verifications, degree verifications, etc. will need your written permission before any of this information can be released to a third party, such as a health insurance company or prospective employer.

**5. Elective Schedules:** Lists of recommended Elective courses for each major are on-line ([www.nocphmph.org](http://www.nocphmph.org) under "Programs"/"Curriculum Design". These courses as well as courses not listed may be considered to fulfill your program requirements for Elective courses. Also, course designated for a specific major, may serve as elective for another major. The Electives chosen must support the major knowledge and skill areas associated with your declared major (i.e., ENVH, HPRO, PHAD, PHEP, or PHNU). Also note, in all cases prior to registration, all elective courses must be approved by your Major Coordinator or Advisor as appropriate for your major and Plan of Study. Finally, for the overall Plan of Study, electives must be completed at both UT and BGSU. Please check the respective institution's website posted or hardcopy published university/college schedule for days and times that specific Elective courses are available.

**6. Capstone Seminar:** Please refer to your on-line *NOCPH Student Handbook* ([www.nocphmph.org](http://www.nocphmph.org)) to determine your eligibility. Student must complete 33 hours of coursework prior to registering for the Capstone Seminar. If you believe you are eligible, contact your Program Director for permission.

**7. Contact Hours:** All courses will satisfy requirements for an appropriate number of equivalent contact hours (e.g., ~15 hours/1 scr./semester). This may be accomplished, however, through a variety of possible modes, including all in-class/lab activities plus assignments or via a combination of in-class/lab activities supplemented by outside projects beyond normal assignments, internet modules ("web-enhanced"), etc.
